Today's BBC Classic Track was the first American hit single from Genesis.

Until the release of this song, the band had been best known for it's album success. But the shock departure of the charismatic Peter Gabriel in 1975, had forced changes on the group - including a switch for the band's drummer, Phil Collins, who became the new lead singer.

By 1978 Genesis were a trio. Guitarist Steve Hackett had quit, leaving Phil Collins, Tony Banks and Mike Rutherford to record the album 'And Then There Were Three'. It was the start for the Genesis we know today and the album included this Classic Track. Recorded live by the BBC at the Knebworth Festival in 1978, here's Genesis - 'Follow You, Follow Me'.

And yet, it was only after the band was reduced to a trio that Genesis enjoyed consistent International success!

The album which started the story for Genesis we know today was 'And Then There Were Three', released in 1978. Today's Classic Track is a song from that record captured here in concert at the 1978 Knebworth Festival.
